The main aim of **Statsbuddy** is to provide industrial people and researchers help in Statistics through our college students who are interested in their research topic or Industrial Project. The session aimed to provide participants with valuable insights into the world of web scraping, its applications, and practical tips for effective implementation.

AWS and Cloud Computing - On December 1st, 2023, Our Star Alumni, Arjun Ghose, conducted a well-rounded session on AWS and cloud Computing

National Sample Survey - On October 30, 2023, Mr. Jayaprakash Sudhir Honrao, who holds the position of joint director at NSSO, led the ISS Career Counseling session focused on the National Sample Survey.

Mr. Honrao highlighted both the recently completed and ongoing surveys conducted by the National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) and underscored the accessibility and relevance of government-provided data, especially for the benefit of students.

The session concluded with an engaging question and answer round, fostering collaborative learning for the students.

Genesis of Idea to IP - Genesis of idea to IP was organised on September 4th, 2023, by Mr. Satish Ranade.

He started by explaining the difference between entrepreneurship and start-ups. He explained the legalities for the same. He talked about patents and how you can protect your ideas by making patents on them. He also elaborated on the organisations, contacts, and compliances used for legal help.

Students got a brief idea about the steps or process required to start with IP. It was a great opportunity to learn about the process of entrepreneurship and how to implement your ideas.

Indian Statistical System and Career Opportunities - A Career Guidance Session was conducted on September 2, 2023. The guest speaker was Dr. Ruhi Kulkarni, Senior Research Officer, Central Water and Power Research Station.

Dr. Ruhi Kulkarni detailed her journey in preparing for the UPSC examination for the Indian Statistical Service; she explained the various rounds in the ISS examination, including the preliminary, main, and interview rounds. She highlighted the importance of a well-rounded preparation strategy to excel in each stage. Dr. Ruhi Kulkarni provided practical tips for preparing for the ISS examination. She stressed the importance of time management, self-discipline, and consistent effort.

The primary objective of the sports committee was to ensure the active participation of institute students in diverse sporting events, fostering a sense of excitement and enthusiasm for sports activities. Throughout the academic year 2023-24, the Department of Sports and Recreational Wellness (DSRW) organised various sports events, with the Symbiosis Statistical Institute (SSI) actively participating in all competitions.

Commencing in August, SSI engaged in a series of events encompassing Table Tennis, Squash, Yoga, Swimming, Chess, and Badminton. September saw SSI students participating in a multitude of sports competitions, including Tennis, Volleyball, Karate/Taekwondo, Handball, Basketball, Cheerleading, and Powerlifting. Notably, October witnessed a pause in sporting events, while November featured competitions in Athletics, Football, Cricket, and Best Physique competitions.

Plans are underway to create a jersey reveal video in the upcoming weeks. Additionally, the month of February marked the organisation of the initial round of Mr. and Mrs. SYMBIFIT at Lavale HillTop, with active participation from SSI students. The institute also provides access to sports equipment to benefit its students.

Despite commendable efforts, SSI faced early exits in Table Tennis, Badminton, and Volleyball, with all matches being closely contested. In Yoga, SSI successfully progressed through the initial rounds but fell short of securing medals. Although a participant reached the finals in Swimming, a medal eluded the institute. Chess standings placed SSI at the 13th position out of 22 participating institutes. In Football, the team secured victory in the first match but narrowly lost the second by a single point. Similarly, in Cricket, SSI won the first round but faced defeat in the subsequent one. Several SSI students have also qualified for the finals in the SYMBIFIT competition.
